**Dominican Memorial weekend**

– this weekend we commemorate the foundation of our parishes by Fr.Thomas Norton in 1759 and the service to them by the Dominican Order for 234 years. There will be prayers said at all Masses and an opportunity to visit the grave of Fr.Tom in Aston Flamville church graveyard at 9.00am and to walk round the graves of the Dominican priests and sisters in Hinckley cemetery at 11.00am. Please do join us if you can.

**First Communion 2026** – will be taking place on the weekend of June 20/21 with Mass for Group A on Saturday at 2.00pm and on Sunday for Group B at 2.30pm. **A truly remarkable letter** – a fortnight ago, during our Sunshine Club evening, we were writing letters to people (as St.Paul had done) and one young lady, aged 14 wrote the following to Pope Leo, which she has given permission for us to print here:  
 Your holiness Pope Leo,

I pray that this message reaches you wrapped in peace and surrounded by God's grace. I want to thank you with all my heart for everything you have given to the Church and to the world. Your words have lifted spirits, your compassion has healed wounds we cannot always see and your courage has shown us what true faith looks like. For young people like me, your example is not just inspiring – it is grounding. It reminds us that goodness still has a voice. Sometimes, as young people, we feel small in a world that moves so fast and asks too much. But your guidance helps us to believe that even the smallest acts of love can echo far beyond what we imagine. You teach us that hope is not naïve, that kindness is not weakness and that faith is not something we carry alone. We want to inspire others the way you inspire us – by choosing compassion when anger is easier, by offering help when it is inconvenient, and by standing up for those who feel unseen. We want to live with open hearts, to listen deeply and to build communities where there is no one. If we can do that, even in small ways, then we believe we can carry forward the light you have shared with us. Thank you, your holiness, for being a shepherd to so many and a source of strength to those who are still learning how to walk their path.
